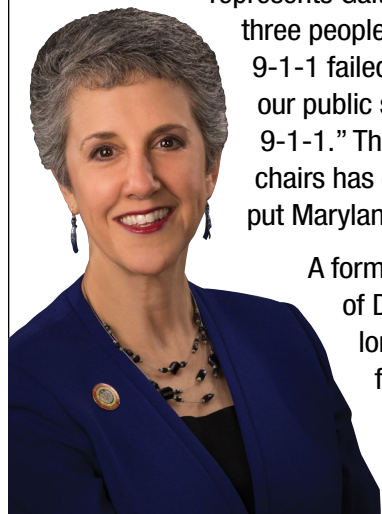
A former member of the House of Delegates, Sen. Kagan is a longtime leader in (and advocate for!) the nonprofit sector.

Since 2003, Kagan has hosted "Folk 'N Great Music," which presents national singer/songwriters in Rockville. She is a nationally ranked Scrabble competitor and is proud to have lured the National Championships to Baltimore that will finally happen in July of 2022!
